EVENTS & ACTIVITIES

ANGEL TREE

This is an annual BOSS event to benefit children at Fort Leavenworth and Kaw Valley Orphanage. Starting in November, BOSS places angels on a Christmas tree displayed in the PX. The angel tags list children by gender and age. Patrons select an angel on the tree, purchase a gift for them, and place the gift with the angel tag back under the tree. BOSS then takes the gift, wraps it, and gives it to the child. BOSS has collected over 5,000 gifts since starting the program.
